FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

ANZAC CEREMONY (at school)

On **Friday 24th April** at 11:45am, Dundula State School will be holding an ANZAC CEREMONY for students, families and the community. Please join us as we remember those who have served in the World Wars. The ceremony will run for approximately 30 to 45 minutes. This year is the 100th anniversary so it is important that we showcase to our students the meaning behind the ceremony. I hope to use the ceremony as a learning experience for our children about the protocols of such an event. I hope you will all join us for this important event.

ANZAC CEREMONY (Saturday)

On Saturday morning, **25th April**, our school will be marching in the ANZAC Parade in town. We march each year, with pride. I would really like to see **all** students attend this year's 100th anniversary **ANZAC parade** this Saturday. Our School Captains will lay a wreath on the day. Please ensure the children are dressed in school uniform. Please ensure they wear a hat and bring a water bottle with them. We will meet in the old Coles Carpark – Sydney Street at 8am. I welcome any parents attending to walk with us. Those students in the band will need to ensure they have all the necessary equipment with them on the day.

STEP INTO PREP

Dundula will commence a **Step into Prep** program for children aged between 2 and 4. This will commence in Week 2 and will run every Friday from 9am to 11am. The program will be supervised by Mrs Irene O'Brien (our teacher aide) who has a vast background in this area. She will be supported by a volunteer teacher aide each week.
